1. What are the classes offered in Ramana Vidyalaya?

2. What is the educational board followed by the School?

6. What is the procedure for Admission ?

Once the registration form is submitted online, candidates will go through an individual assessment, which will be followed by a personal interview with the parents. Date and time for both the processes will be intimated by school through email.

7. When the registration form to be submitted to school ?

Registration form along with the mandatory documents listed to be submitted to the school office during your personal interview.

8. What are the mandatory documents to be submitted along with hard copy of the form?

- a. Copy of birth certificate.
- b. Copy of PAN Card of the parent
- c. Copy of residence proof
- d. Copy of community certificate
- e. Copy of the aadhaar card of the parent if available
- f. Copy of immunization certificate

9. Does the school provide transportation for students?

Yes. School van plies through a pre-planned route.

10. Is Day care is available after school hours?

Yes, day care facility is there in school campus and can be availed till 6.30 p.m.

11. What is the mode of communication with the students and staff as my child does not know the local language?

English is the common language used in school for communication with each other and with students.
